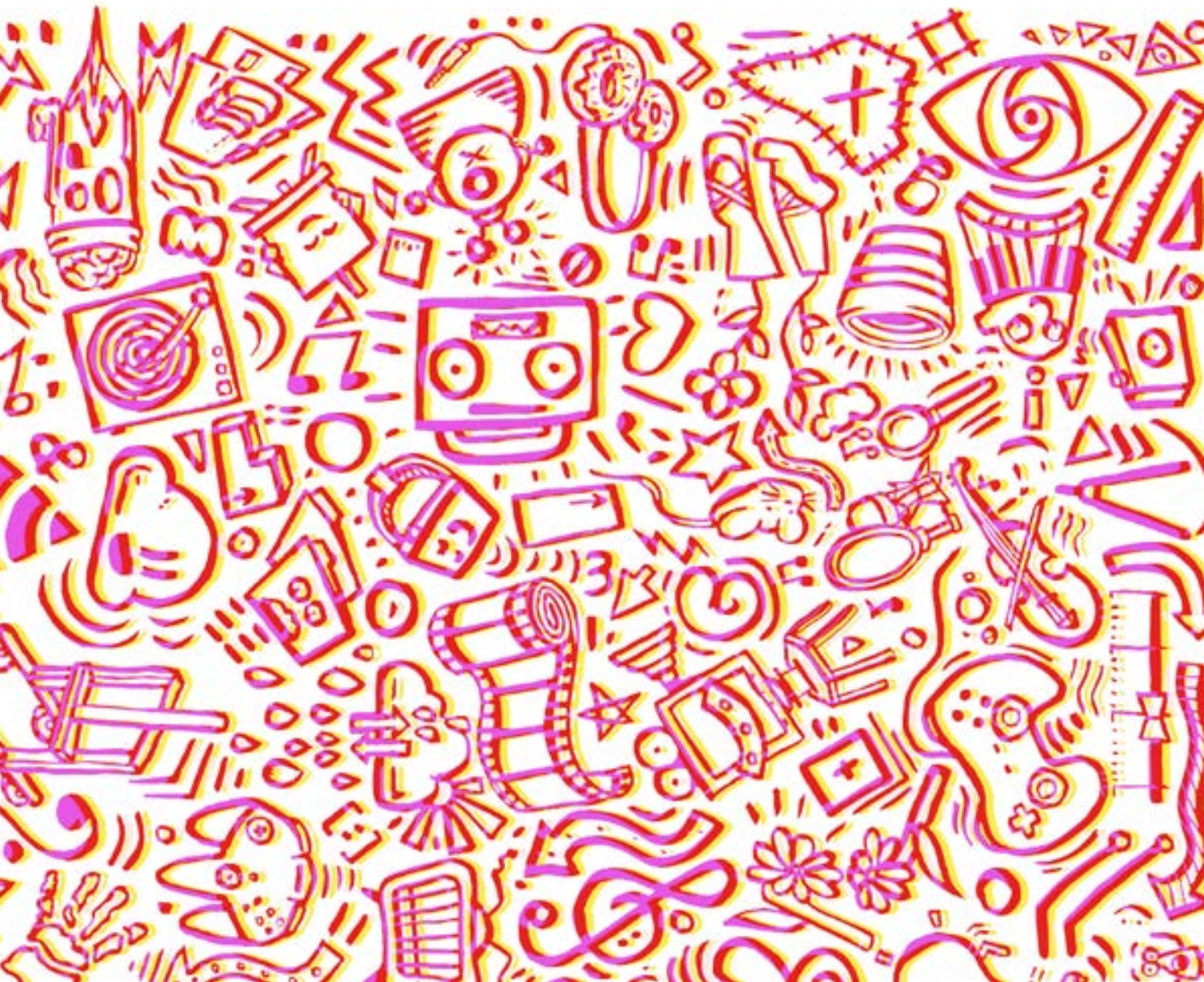
THE SKINNY
